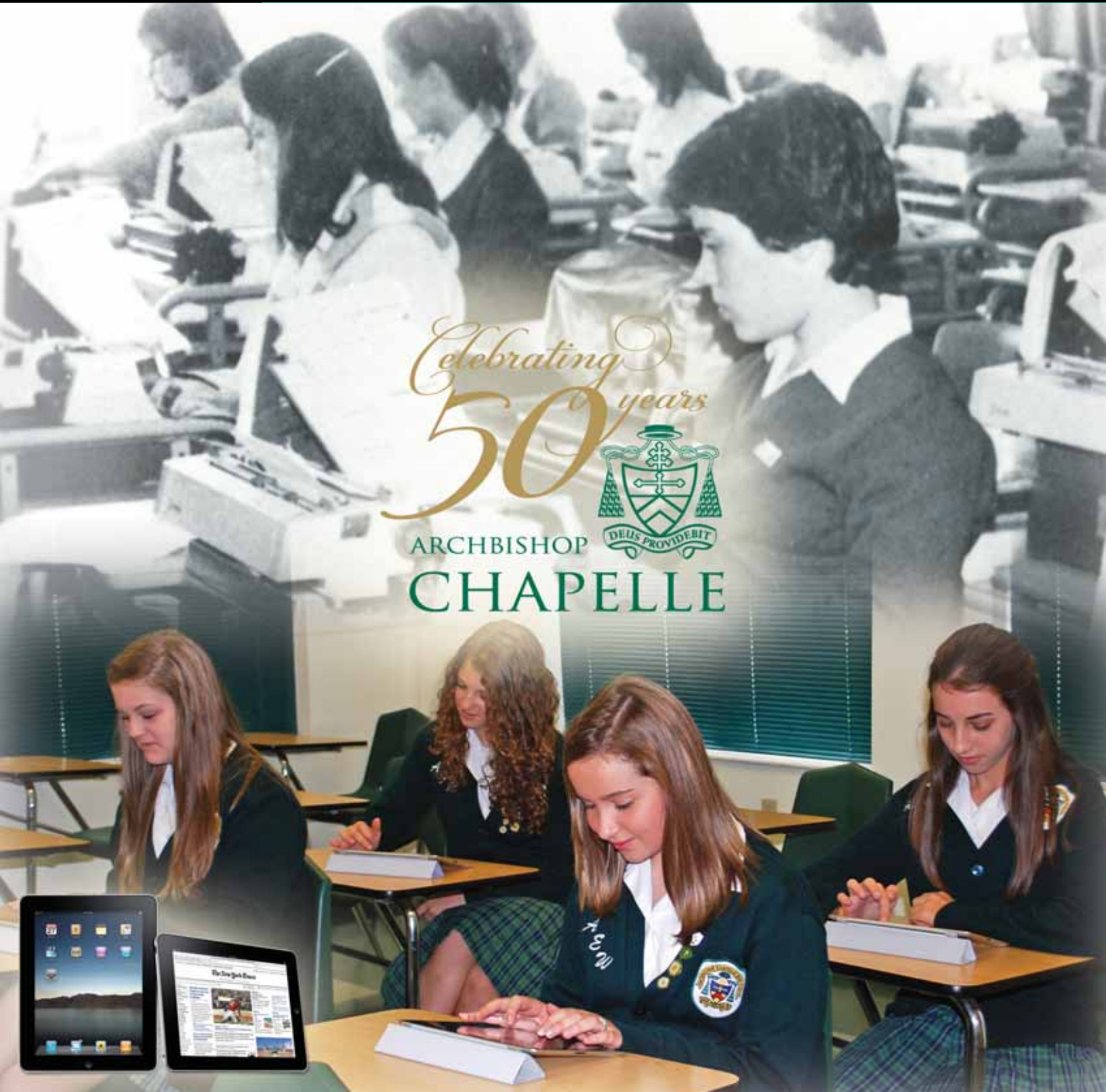

Over the last 50 years Chapelle has graduated over 11,000 alumnae who have made a difference in the world. Fay Lewis Retires

When Fay Lewis began teaching at Archbishop Chapelle High School 45 years ago, Veterans Highway (not Boulevard!) was a two lane road from David Drive to Williams Blvd. There were fewer buildings on campus, and more students in every classroom. Having a class of 36 was very normal. Through her many years at Chapelle, she has taught Biology to thousands of young women, in some cases, teaching grandmother, mother and granddaughter. She also raised a family of her own, two daughters (both of whom graduated from Chapelle) and a son, and always lived only a few steps from campus. In her later years, the sight of Mrs. Lewis pedaling to school on her three-wheeler became a familiar sight.



But her strength was always in her teaching. She taught countless numbers of us the difference between looking at something through the microscope or with the "nekkid eye". She supervised dissections, lectured, demonstrated, held pet shows for her Biology II classes and personally taught me the difference between polled and unpolled cattle (A polled animal is one that was born without horns. The polled trait is determined by a genetic variation on cattle chromosome 1) and what those implications were for genetic research. That prompted some lively dinner conversation at our house for some reason.

The numerous students Mrs. Lewis taught that chose careers in Science credit her with teaching them how to study, and instilling in them a love for science. She certainly taught us how to study (I got my first B in high school from her). We have a generation of doctors and nurses, chemists and physical therapists that received their first taste of Biology from the red head in Room 110. Thank you Fay, for inspiring all of us, for your many years of service to Chapelle, and for consistently demanding excellence from your students while preparing us for college and life.

Archbishop Chapelle High School held its forty-sixth Baccalaureate Mass and Commencement Exercises on Tuesday, May 17, 2011.

The Baccalaureate Mass was celebrated at St. Philip Neri Church in Metairie at 11:00 in the morning. The Reverend Msgr. Robert D. Massett presided.

Mrs. Jane Ann Frosch, Archbishop Chapelle President, made a special presentation to **Miss Noel Marie Netzhammer** (Yvette Thevenot '85), **the 2011 Archbishop Chapelle High School Outstanding Catholic Student**. This is the highest honor a Chapelle student can receive and is presented annually at the Baccalaureate Mass to a senior who demonstrates the following ideals in her Catholic Christian life: moral and ethical behavior based on Christ's teachings; a character and attitude which reflect Catholic principles; a concern for the Chapelle community and daily life on campus; and involvement in her church parish as well as service to the broader community.

The Commencement was held at 7:00 in the evening at the Pontchartrain Center. Mrs. Cathy Yaeger, Principal of Archbishop Chapelle High School, conferred diplomas on 179 seniors. Mrs. Jane Ann Frosch recognized scholarship and financial award recipients.

At the ceremony, **Miss Jennifer Ann Boudreaux** was named as the **2011 Valedictorian**. She is the daughter of Stephen and Dayna McGovern Boudreaux '78 of Metairie.

Jennifer was a Summa Cum Laude Graduate with Gold Status Commendation. She received the President's Award for Educational Excellence, the Knights of Columbus Catholic Youth Leadership Award, the Alton Ochsner Future Physician Award, the Mu Alpha Theta Medallion Award and the Presidential Service Award. She earned Distinguished Honor Roll and Exemplary Conduct for all five years of her high school career. Jennifer participated in the NCTE Achievement Awards in Writing Contest and in the Louisiana Students of the Year Awards Program.

Jennifer is the president of Mu Alpha Theta, the secretary of the National Honor Society, an executive board member of Campus Ministry, an Ambassador Officer and a Pro-Life Club Officer. Friends

The Class of '75 has it all together! These *Friends* (Senior class motto and class song) were forced to cancel their 30-year reunion in early September 2005. Class members, glued to TV screens and waiting to return to their homes, watched their reunion “go up in smoke” as the Southern Yacht Club (site of the planned reunion), burned to the ground in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina. But the spirit of the Class of '75 could not be broken—several classmates vowed to bring the *Friends* together again, without waiting five years for the next class reunion.

In October 2008, an email blast went out, inviting class members to a social at a local restaurant. Even though they were given only a couple of days' notice, 14 girls showed up for dinner that night. Little did they know that this was the beginning of something very special. Their first thought was to meet again in January, and continue to do so quarterly. But these *Friends* could not be held back—they gathered again at the home of a classmate in November, with 25 girls attending. In December, they held a Christmas party at a classmate's home and 45 girls were in attendance.

In the months following, socials were held monthly, with 20-60 girls attending each event. But this wasn't enough for the *Friends*. To celebrate the one-year anniversary of that first social, the girls decided to plan a trip together. In October of 2009, 53



girls (yes, just girls!) sailed on the *Carnival Fantasy* out of New Orleans. It was sometime after that cruise that the Class of '75 became known as the *Chipstas* (Chipmunk *Sistas*). The *Chipstas* cruised again, on the *Carnival Triumph* in October of 2010 (70 girls attending!) and cruise again on the *Carnival Ecstasy* this October. The *Chipstas* have invited all alums of Chapelle to join in this year's cruise.

From October 2008 to the present, the *Chipstas* have renewed old friendships, made new friendships, laughed 'til they cried, and mourned together upon the sudden deaths of two of their classmates. The *Chipstas* have supported each other in good times—children's graduations, birth of a grandchild; and in bad—with the caring for and passing of aging parents and the untimely death of several siblings.

Some of the gatherings have included Corks N Canvas, Swimming Parties, Luncheons, Dinners, Live Theatre, monthly Birthday Dinners, bi-monthly Bunco games, and Chapelle alumnae functions such as Cocktails in the Courtyard, the Prayer Breakfast, and the Emerald Gala.

Last year, the Class of '75 made a donation to the Emerald Gala of four tickets to see *Wicked* and lunch at a local restaurant, in addition to being a Board Sponsor for the event. This past year, the Class donated a cruise for two on the *Carnival Triumph* in October 2011 for a Gala Raffle which brought in over \$1,200! The Class also purchased two tables at the annual Prayer Breakfast.

The *Chipstas* have taken part in several service projects throughout the community, and continue to do so regularly. There is also a class *e-mail prayer chain*, where members can request prayers for themselves and for family members and friends.

Last July, the Class of '75 held its 35-year class reunion at—you guessed it—the Southern Yacht Club, where 260 were in attendance, including 151 members of the Class of '75! Several former teachers were also in attendance.

For out-of-town *Chipstas* (who can't be forgotten and who want to be a part of it) there are special “last-minute” socials whenever it is determined that one of the girls is back in town! This last-minute email blast always brings out a large turnout to greet the *wandering sheep coming back to the fold!*

The Class of '75 has updated information for over 90% of its class, and members communicate regularly via phone, email and Facebook. If you would like to get YOUR class members back in touch again, the *Chipstas* would be more than happy to help you get started—just ask!
